¹ONC uses the the SK&A office-based provider database (2013) to estimate the number of physicians (MD/DOs), physician assistants (PAs), and nurse practitioners (NPs) in each state. These estimates include more providers than are eligible to participate in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) EHR Incentive Programs. Accordingly, estimates in this table underestimate the percentage of eligible providers in each state that are participating in the CMS EHR Incentive Programs. These estimates approximately reflect the percentage of all U.S. office-based physicians, NPs, and PAs who have adopted certified EHR technology in each state and nationally. ²The unduplicated count of MD/DOs, NPs, and PAs who have demonstrated meaningful use of certified health IT through the CMS' EHR Incentive Programs.
